PRIVACY NOTICE

Who Are We?

In this notice, "Disley Bellringers", "We", "Us" and "Our" refer to St Mary's Guild of Bellringers, Disley.

What is Personal Data?

Personal Data is classified as any information relating to a living person who could be identified from either that data alone or by combining with other information that We hold or could access.

What Personal Data Do We Collect?

We may collect personal data about you as part of your membership of Our group. This includes:

- Name
- Email Address
- Telephone Number
- Home Address

How Do We Use Your Personal Data?

We use your data for the following purposes :

- To arrange and keep you informed about ringing practices, events, and guild activities
- To arrange social events

Who Do We Share Your Data With?

Depending on your membership of/relationship to Disley Bellringers we may share your information with:

- Chester Diocesan Guild of Church Bellringers so that they can administer your membership of the guild
- Other members of Disley Bellringers for the purposes of co-ordinating of ringing or social events

How Long Do We Keep Your Data?

We will retain your personal data for the duration of your membership of/relationship with Us, unless you choose to withdraw your consent at which point your data would be securely disposed of.

How Do We Keep Your Data Secure?

Access to your data is restricted based on the options agreed to in your completion of our Data Privacy Consent Form. We store your data securely, and will not use or share it for any purpose which you have not explicitly agreed to in completing Our consent form.

What Are Your Rights?

Unless subject to an exemption, under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) you have the right to:

- Request a copy of the data that We hold about you
- Request that We correct any inaccuracies in the data We are holding about you
- Request that We delete the data that We hold about you
- Withdraw your consent to Us processing your data
